#### Green Building Award [GBA]

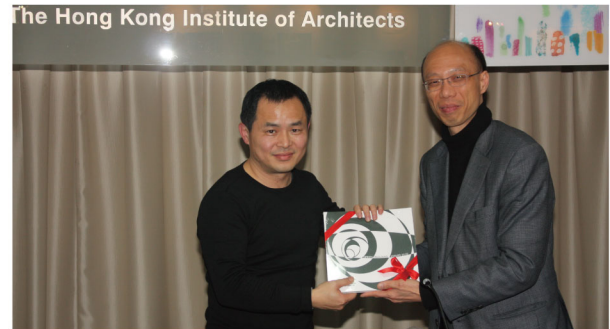
